Statement on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)

The objective of this Regulation is to protect human health and the environment from persistent organic pollutants in products within the European Union. It is necessary to establish a common legal framework within which measures can be taken aimed in particular at eliminating the manufacturing, placing them on the market and use of intentionally produced POPs.

In relation to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021, we can provide the following information on the market provision and use of **Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)**.

Throughout the manufacturing and packaging process of Endress+Hauser products, no materials or ingredients of persistent organic pollutants mentioned in Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 are used. Thus, we confirm the absence of POPs.

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
